IPOC Report (Donna Davis):

Preliminary findings:

- Survey results: 62 responses, 20 % "Won't miss it" 50 % "Will come again". Overall score 4.3/5
 - Some Comments: "very convenient sharing of information", "liked the recycling sessions", "liked the 50th yr session", "Student networking was great", "Wednesday bag lunch came short"
- **Sponsorships:** \$91,600 may be a record, still waiting for a \$15,000 dollar commitment. Souvenir backpacks well liked. Door prizes on Wednesday were very successful.
- Exhibitors: 63 exhibitors.
- Technical Program: 128 technical presentations, 3 keynote speakers and a tutorial session.
- **Registration**: 883 attendees. \$260,000 collected on registration fees.
- Opportunities for improvement will be reported with final report.
